Option Subjects: French, Art, Music, Engineering, Construction Studies, Design and Communication Graphics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Geography, Social and Scientific, Business Organisation, Accounting.

All students take the core subjects and choose an additional four subjects from a choice of 14 subjects.

Transition Year

Transition Year offers a broad educational experience for our students helping them to mature and become ready for further study in senior cycle. There are many extra curricular activities throughout the year and students have access to a wide and varied range of subjects.
