UCC PLUS⁺ is about YOU and YOUR future!


Education plays a crucial role in the intellectual, personal and social development of each individual. Third level education is seen as increasingly necessary for a good quality of life and broader and more exciting career opportunities. However, research has shown that many groups are still underrepresented at third level. UCC PLUS⁺ strives to target such students and support them to progress to and succeed in third level education. The programme involves 3 core strands: Schools Programme, **Higher Education Access Route** (HEAR) Scheme, Post-Entry College Support Programme.

Who is UCC PLUS⁺ for?

UCC PLUS⁺ is for students that have an academic ability to succeed at third level, but for a variety of socioeconomic reasons may be prevented from doing so. Students would typically come from lower-income households, with little or no tradition of progression to third level.

Traveller Mentoring Programme



Route (HEAR) Scheme

The Higher Education Access Route (HEAR) Scheme provides an alternative entry route to college/university. HEAR applicants must meet a range of financial social and cultural criteria to be considered for a reduced points place and extra college supports.
